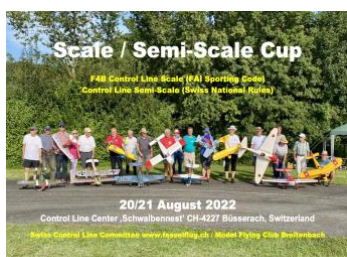

Dear colleagues

Even after the second Corona year, the Swiss control line pilots have not lost their optimism. The most important events and dates for the new season have been set and the first organisational steps have been taken. We are happy to inform you about our plans for 2022 in this Newsletter.

The first event starts on 9 April. The Bern Model Flying Group will once again be inviting the Swiss control line pilots to Mühlethurnen for the **season-opening flying**. An event that is already taking place for the 17<sup>th</sup> time and enjoys great popularity!

After a short break, the **Swiss Championships** in the categories Speed, Team Racing and Aerobatics will follow on 25/26 June. It will be held at the 'Schwalbennest' control line flying site near Büsserach. And as is the long-standing tradition, foreign participants are also very welcome.

Two major events will follow in August and September.

The international **Scale/Semi-Scale Cup** will be organized for the eighth time in 2022. What started as an experiment in 2015 has become a top event in the European control line Scale scene in just a few years. On 20/21 August it will be that time again. However, there is a change regarding the venue: Since the 'Hard 2000' flying facility in Untersiggenthal is unfortunately no longer available, the event will also take place in the 'Schwalbennest'. Hopefully, by this time there will be no more Corona-related restrictions and participants from all over Europe can be expected again.

The next international event, the **JURA CUP**, will follow on 24/25 September. This traditional **WORLD CUP** competition will also 2022 be held in the F2B Aerobatics category – and again in the 'Schwalbennest'. The previous plan to hold the JURA CUP annually, alternating between Aerobatics and Speed/Team Racing, will not be pursued for the time being on request of competitors and the organiser.

In addition to these competitions, it will hopefully also be possible to organise spontaneous friendship and fun flights. Furthermore, the attractive control line flying exhibition at the Swiss Museum of Transport in Lucerne will run until July. Your visit should not be missed.
